

Instructions for Skin Immunofluorescence

1. We strongly recommend obtaining two biopsies. One should be submitted in Michel's preservative (available from ORH) for immunofluorescence and the other in formalin for H&E stain.
If you already have an H&E-stained slide, please send a recut and pathology report.
2. Send specimen at room temperature with a completed requisition form, including clinical history, to:
